Music Skills	<p>Through each topic, children will be taught the key Music skills:</p> <p>KS1 - Pupils will be taught to: use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes; play tuned and un-tuned instruments musically; Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music; experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music</p> <p>KS2 - Pupils will be taught to: play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression; improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music; listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory; use and understand staff and other musical notations</p>
