Parking

You will have seen the separate ParentMail message we sent out yesterday regarding complaints about parking. As a reminder to everyone, this is the message we sent out:-

Over the last 24 hours we have received 4 separate complaints regarding parking near to our school.

1. One local resident has advised us that they have had white "H markings" painted across their driveway and parents continue to park across the driveway block the entrance.
2. We have received a complaint about parents using abusive language to a resident.
3. One of our parents has, we understand, repeatedly parked their car in the staff car park blocking entry for staff.
4. We have had it reported to us that a family member was parked on the corner of Oriel Drive and Oriel Close, where double yellow lines are present, blocking the pavement for pedestrians – the registration number has been reported to the police.

May we appeal to all of you to please park with consideration for local residents but more importantly with due care and consideration for the safety of all the children in Holy Rosary.
